



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Offered exclusively to interns of Lansing 5:01's sponsors, attendees will partake in a one-of-a-kind dining experience at the Wharton Center for Performing Arts. While enjoying a plated dinner on the main stage - where performances such as *Wicked* and *Hamilton* have graced the stage - guests will learn the art of etiquette from etiquette expert Rachel Bartels. Bartels will guide emerging professionals through dinner to prepare them to wow their future (and current!) bosses. After, hear from MSU Federal Credit Union about how you can set yourself up for financial success - in college and beyond. The event serves as the standing ovation for the Lansing 5:01 summer event series and the summer intern program for sponsoring employers.

Where can attendees park the night of the event? Where exactly is the event at Wharton Center?

Attendees can park for free anywhere on MSU's campus after 6:00 pm on the day of the event. There is a parking ramp connected to Wharton Center, in which parking is \$1.80 per hour and is pay by plate between the hours of 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. Adjacent to the Wharton Center is the Shaw Lane Parking Ramp, located at 592 N Shaw Ln, East Lansing, MI 48824. This ramp is free parking after 6:00 p.m. You can also take the CATA bus to get to the event.

The cocktail hour will be hosted directly outside the main entrance of Wharton Center. In the event of rain, the cocktail hour will be hosted inside the lobby. The program and dinner portion of the event will be held in the Great Hall at Wharton Center on the stage.

What is proper attire for this event?

Please dress in cocktail attire for this event. Cocktail attire is slightly less dressy than 'formal' attire, but a step more formal than 'business' attire. For women, dresses, skirts, or dress pants with nice tops are perfectly acceptable. For men, trousers with a shirt and vest or jacket are acceptable, as well. Above all though, please dress to your comfort, both in terms of weather and your style.

Will I have to pay for anything?

No! There is no fee to attend the event and all food and drinks are complementary.

Am I allowed to bring guests? When do I need to register by?

No. This event is exclusively for interns from sponsoring companies of Lansing 5:01. Interns are required to register by July 28, 2019 in order to secure the final catering order to send to the catering company. We kindly request that attendees do their best to attend if they register, as we do pay per plate.

You're welcome to check-in starting at 5:01 pm. There will be a mix & mingle from 5:01 pm - 6:00 pm with mocktails and conversation. The event will not officially start until 6:00 p.m. The event will wrap up around 7:45 p.m.
